# 5. TEAMS/ COMPETITORS

One team consists of 12 players and 3 substitutes

At most 12 teams are allowed to take part in this tournament. (the PANTHERs of the STC GRAZ included) Representative teams and player communities from different teams are also accepted.

#### 6. RULES

The official rules of the CMAS are valid during the tournament. The way and the time of playing depend on the number of the teams, who take part in the competition. The sequence of playing will be defined at the conference of the team leaders.

## 7. PLAYING AREA

# 8. REFEREE

Every team has to have two referees with a valid license for the current year. A fee of 25,-  $\in$  will be charged for every missing referee.

# 9. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TOURNAMENT

The administration is introduced at the open-air swimming pool.

## **10. PROTESTS**

Protests have to be placed up to 30 minutes after the match on paper by the team captain at the administration.

## **11. PRESENTATION CEREMONY**

The presentation ceremony is held at about one hour after the last game at the restaurant of the swimming pool. There you will also have the possibility to have dinner at your own costs.

## **12. LIABILITY**
